

Appendix 6.1 - Covid-19 Protocol when arriving outside Finland

COVID-19 Protocol of Arctic Rally Finland 2021 for Attendees coming from other countries than Finland

- 1) The Covid-19 Accreditation form must be submitted latest Monday 15th February by All Attendees (includes the Self Declaration for COVID-19 risks):
 → Must be submitted by using official Google Forms, link will be available in the event website www.arcticrallyfinland.fi

2) All the forms required by FIA must be submitted to covid-19@aturheilu.fi and covid_WRC@fia.com at latest Monday 15th February 17:00 (16:00 CET) by All Attendees

- Each stakeholder must issue an invitation letters for all its attendees by event Organizer AKK indicating essential work-related reason for travel (without this entering to Finland in the border will not be allowed).

- A negative PCR test (**max. 72hrs prior to entering Finland**) is mandatory for all Attendees at the border of Finland.
 → The negative test result must be submitted immediately after receiving it by using official Google Forms, link will be available in the event website www.arcticrallyfinland.fi



All attendees need COVID-19 test (PCR/Antigen) when arriving to Rovaniemi. Check the opening hours of the Covid Test Center and COVID Accreditation and more information from the event website.

- Mandatory quarantine at accommodation place until the result is received. The test provider will inform the results by SMS to the Attendee himself/herself and the results will be sent also directly to COVID-19 Medical Officer of the event.

✓ Negative test result

- Attendee must collect the bracelet from the COVID-19 Accreditation of the event **before entering any event areas**
- With the bracelet the Attendee has the access to the event areas according the profile given

✗ Positive test result

- **No access to the event**
- **Person must stay in quarantine**

Note: Any attendees entering Finland more than 72 hours before the opening of High Density Area (truck drivers, set-up crew, test teams, competition crews) will require a negative PCR test not more than 96 hours old at the time of high density area opening in order to receive accreditation.

Appendix 6.1 - Covid-19 Protocol when arriving from Finland

COVID-19 Protocol of Arctic Rally Finland 2021 for Attendees coming from within Finland to Rovaniemi

- 1) The Covid-19 Accreditation form must be submitted latest Monday 15th February by All Attendees (includes the Self Declaration for COVID-19 risks):

→ Must be submitted by using official Google Forms, link will be available in the event website www.arcticrallyfinland.fi

- 2) All the forms required by FIA must be submitted to covid-19@autourheilu.fi and covid_WRC@fia.com at latest Monday 15th February 17:00 (16:00 CET) by All Attendees

- If the Attendee from Finland is going to be accredited as Low Density Accreditation, he/she is required to make a rapid / antigen test in Rovaniemi.

- If the Attendee from Finland is going to be accredited as High Density Accreditation, he/she is required to make PCR test at the residence town max. 48 hours before coming to Rovaniemi. The second rapid / antigen test in Rovaniemi is mandatory.

→ IF the PCR test is not taken at Mehiläinen facilities, submit your test result by using official Google Forms, link will be available in the event website www.arcticrallyfinland.fi



All attendees need COVID-19 test (PCR/Antigen) when arriving to Rovaniemi. Check the opening hours of the Covid Test Center and COVID Accreditation and more information from the event website.
